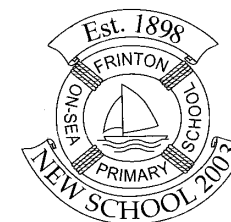

- Encourage independence as their child progresses through the school.
- Reinforce and monitor safe and responsible use of the internet.
- Promote positive attitudes towards school and learning.
