Over Subscription Criteria

There is no guarantee of a place for children living in the priority admission area.

In the event of oversubscription places will be allocated using the following criteria in the order given:

1. Looked after children; 'A looked after child' or a child who was previously looked after, became subject to an adoption, residence or special guardianship order. A looked after child is a child who is (a) in the care of a local authority, or (b) being provided with accommodation by a local authority in the exercise of their social services functions (see the definition in section 22(1) of the Children Act 1989).
2. Children who, at the time of consideration, can prove that they reside in the priority admission area who have a brother, sister, stepbrother or stepsister living in the same family unit in the same family household and address who will be attending the school on the date of entry.
3. Children who, at the time of consideration, can prove that they reside in the priority admission area.
4. Remaining applications.

In the event of oversubscription within any of the above criteria, priority will be determined by straight line distance from home to school, those living closest being given the highest priority. Exceptional medical or special educational needs circumstances (supported by medical evidence) may override the above (other than Looked After Children and previously looked after children).

Appeals Procedure

Parents are advised that they do have a right of appeal from the decision of the Admissions Authority to refuse a place at the school. Information on how to appeal would be provided with any Essex County Council refusal letter.
