### Sports Premium Overview

#### What is Sports Premium?

The Government is providing funding of £150 Million per annum for academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15 to provide new, sustainable and substantial primary school sport funding. This funding is being jointly met and provided by the Departments for Education, Health & Culture and Media and Sport - and shall see money going directly to primary school Headteachers and Principals to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. The sport funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision at Frinton-on-Sea Primary School.

#### Objectives of Spend

Improve the provision and quality of PE & Sport at Frinton-on-Sea Primary School.  
Ensure that PE & School Sport is judged as at least good by external monitoring.  
Broaden the sporting opportunities and experiences available to pupils.  
To develop a love of sport and physical activity.
